Circular

**Subject:- Filling up of 12 (Twelve) posts of Deputy Director (Plg/Stats.) in Planning and Statistical Cadre, Planning Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi on deputation basis.**

Planning Department invites application in prescribed format from eligible candidates to fill up Twelve (12) vacant post of Deputy Director (Plg/Stats.) in Planning and Statistical Cadre, Planning Department, Govt. of NCT, which is classified as General Central Services - Group 'A' Gazetted-Non Ministerial, carrying pay in Level-11 of Pay Matrix of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC on Deputation basis. The term of deputation will be one year in the initial stage but it may be extended upto three years.

**2. Eligibility qualification and Experience**

Officers under the Central/State Govt/Union Territories/Universities/Recognized Research Institutions/Public Sector Undertakings/ Semi Government/Statutory or Autonomous Organizations:-

(A) (I) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent Cadre/Department; Or

(II) With 05 years' service in the Grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Scale of Pay of Rs. 15600-39100/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 5400/- in Pay Band-3 (Level-10 as per 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) or equivalent in the Parent Cadre/Department; Or

(III) With 06 years' service in the Grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Scale of Pay Rs. 9300-34800/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 4800/- in Pay Band-2 (Level-8 as per 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) or equivalent in the Parent Cadre/Department; Or

(IV) With 07 years' service in the Grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Scale of Pay of Rs.9300-34800/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 4600/- in Pay Band-2 (Level-7 as per 7<sup>th</sup> CPC) or equivalent in the Parent Cadre/Department;

And

(B) Possessing the Educational Qualifications and Experience as mentioned below:-

**Essential:** -

(i) Post Graduate Degree in Statistics/ Operational Research/ Mathematical Statistics/ Applied Statistics or Post Graduate Degree in Economics/Mathematics/ Commerce (with. Statistics/Quantitative Method/ Techniques or Costing & Statistics/Basic Statistics /Business Statistics/Introduction to Statistics etc. as one of subject/papers in Post-Graduation/Graduation level) of a recognized University.

(ii) Five years' experience of Statistical/ Planning work investigation/ Research in a recognized Institute or Department.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC for reasons to be recorded in writing, in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note2: The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the UPSC for reasons to be recorded in writing, in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled castes or Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection the UPSC is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts reserved for them.

**Desirable:**

Doctorate Degree in anyone of the subjects mentioned in E.Q. (i) from recognized university.

**3. Regulation of pay and other terms of deputation:**

The pay of the selected officer will be regulated under the provisions contained in the Department of Personnel and Training O.M.No 6/8/2009-Estt (Pay-II) dated 17.06.2010 as amended from time to time.

**4. Age Limit:** The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

**5. Consultation with Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi:** Consultation with Union Public Service Commission is necessary.



6. **Reservation for Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes:** No provision for reservation exists for the posts to be filled up on deputation basis.

7. It is requested that this circular may be given wide publicity by circulation to all offices / Organizations etc. The applications (in duplicate in the proforma as published in the departmental website <https://delhiplanning.delhi.gov.in> along with the complete Annual Performance Appraisal Report (APAR) Dossiers for last five years of the eligible officers who could be spared in the event of their selection, may be forwarded by the respective employer to The Joint Director, Cadre Controlling Unit, Planning Department, 4th & 6th Level, B-wing, Delhi Secretariat, Government of NCT of Delhi within 06 weeks from the date of publication of this Notification in the Employment News. Besides, the following information / documents may also be sent alongwith application:

- (i) A statement showing minor or major penalties imposed, if any in respect of the official.
- (ii) Cadre Clearance Certificate
- (iii) Integrity Certificate
- (iv) Vigilance Clearance
- (v) Job description of the present post held

8. Applications that are not routed through the competent authority and the applications received after the last date or without the APAR Dossiers or otherwise found incomplete will not be considered. While forwarding the applications, it may be verified and certified by the employer concerned that the particulars furnished by the officers are correct and that no disciplinary case is either pending or contemplated against the Officer. The applicants may please be informed that they will not be permitted to withdraw their application at a later stage.
